AEJMC’s Visual Communication and Communication Technology divisions encourage faculty and graduate students to submit Web sites that enhance or promote education in Journalism or Mass Communication.

Web sites can be in one of the following categories:

1. Department or school
2. Teaching
3. Journalism
4. Creative

Please remember—with the exception of the Journalism category, where the faculty entrant can be the director of the project—the entrant must be more than 50% responsible for the design and execution of the website.

All entries must be visible online. Entries are by URL. Please do not enter sites that have previously won an award.

Deadline for entries is March 31, 2008. Winners will be announced by the end of May 2008.

Awards will be presented at the annual AEJMC national convention (http://www.aejmc.org/events/convention/papercall/uniform_call.php). Winners in this competition are expected to attend the convention and to present their winning site as part of a scheduled convention panel.
